

NWSBL Jamboree

3-Point Contest Rules

1. Tournament Director is Paul Ferry, CDAA, or his designee.
2. No protests are allowed. Referee's and/or tournament director's decisions are final.
3. There will be preliminary rounds all day on Saturday and finals on Sunday. Participants can show up at the 3-point shooting court (West courts in the Champlin Park field house) at their discretion during the preliminary round, sign in and complete their preliminary score(s). Two preliminary round scores are allowed, but only one preliminary round is required. The highest score for an individual round will be used to determine finalists. The two rounds are NOT combined.
4. The top three scores, or more if there are ties, in each contest will advance to the finals. The finalists will be posted at the field house at start of play on Sunday.
5. ***Finals are held at noon on Sunday. You must report to the shooting contest court at noon to check-in and compete.***
6. In both the preliminary and final rounds, up to 3 warm up shots are allowed. The shooter then is timed for 1 minute, and shoots up to 16 shots from 4 spots, with each made shot counting for 1 point.
7. In the finals, the lowest preliminary round goes first and the highest preliminary round score goes last.
8. In the event of a tie, the contestants will have an alternating shot sudden-death shoot off, in the same shooting order.
